## 1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be defined by the rules in the Racing Rules of Sailing: Appendix E and the Dragon Force 65 restricted class rules.

## 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to Dragon Force 65 "stock" boats with A rig only.  
2.2. An eligible boat may enter by agreeing to attend the Facebook event, or by showing up on the day of the race.  
2.3. All boats shall be individually identified with markings on their sails or unique sail numbers.

## 3. FEES

## 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1. The Sailing Instructions will be posted online on the SSYC website. If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.

## 6. RACING AREA

- 6.1. The racing areas will be from the South Shore Yacht Club docks, horse shoe, or the docks by the north or south derricks. The racing area will be determined by the race committee subject to prevailing weather conditions and waves.

## 7. MEASUREMENT

- 7.1. Measurement is on the honor system.  
7.2. All boats shall be raced straight out of the box. No Upgraded rigs or sails are permitted. Boats with lithium battery packs are permitted.

## 8. SCORING

- 8.1. Boats will be scored using the Low Point System as per Appendix A. and as changed per 8.2 and 8.3.
  - 8.2. The value of a DNS (Did Not Start) or DNF (Did Not Finish) shall be the number of boats checked-in.
  - 8.3. The value for a DNC (Did Not Compete) shall be the number of boats checked-in that day plus one (1).
  - 8.4. Throw-outs will be detailed in the sailing instructions.
9. PRIZES
- 9.1. Series Awards: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd overall.
