COVID-19 2020 Season Guidelines

In order to facilitate remote control racing at South Shore Yacht Club, the following rules will be enforced:

Per State of Wisconsin guidance for phased re-opening following the COVID-19 Safer at Home Order, all participants will adhere to the “Individual Guidelines For All Phases” as described in the Badger Bounce Back Plan.

Please refer to the attached for complete plan details and the rules of each individually defined phases for reopening.

CONTINUE TO PRACTICE GOOD HYGIENE

- Wash your hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer, especially after touching frequently used items or surfaces.
- Avoid touching your face.
- Sneeze or cough into a tissue or the inside of your elbow.
- Disinfect frequently used items and surfaces as much as possible.
Strongly consider using cloth face coverings while in public, and particularly when using mass transit.

PEOPLE WHO FEEL SICK MUST STAY AT HOME

- Do NOT go to work, school, or any other public place.
- Contact and follow the advice of your medical provider.

SSYC SPECIFIC SOCIAL DISTANCING RACING GUIDELINES

- Face masks are not mandated but, for the sake of the health and safety of our competitors, they are strongly recommended.
- Each Competitor, Race Committee Member or Spectator must be wearing a Personal Flotation Device (PFD) at ALL times while on the dock.
- During set up, please keep distance between fellow skippers and race committee members.
- A minimum of 6 feet will be required between racers while on the dock.
- Once a starting sequence countdown has begun, the skipper must remain in place and not move around.

- If a boat loses control, a volunteer from the race committee will go retrieve it.

SSYC may revise these guidelines as more information is made available to the Race Committee that may require the need for change.

As always, you will be competing at your own risk and SSYC will not be responsible for any impacts to you as an individual as a result of you or any of your competitors failing to follow the Wisconsin State and Milwaukee County mandated guidelines.
