

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Remote Control Sailing
World Yachts Championship Series A
South Shore Yacht Club
June 7 - July 12

1. RULES

1.1. The regatta will be defined by the rules in the Racing Rules of Sailing: Appendix E and the Dragon Force 65 restricted class rules.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1. The series is open to Dragon Force 65 "stock" with A rig sailboats only.

2.2. All boats shall be raced straight out of the box. No upgraded rigs or sails are permitted.

2.3. Lithium battery packs are permitted.

2.4. An eligible boat may enter by agreeing to attend the facebook event, or by showing up on the day of the race.

2.5. All boats shall be individually identified with markings on their sails or unique sail numbers.

3. FEES

3.1. The events are free

4. SCHEDULE

4.1. The tentative schedule is as follows with no warnings after 5:45pm.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. The Sailing Instructions will be posted online on the SSYC website. If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.

6. RACING AREA

6.1. The racing areas will be from the South Shore Yacht Club docks, horse shoe, or the docks by the north or south derricks. The racing area may be changed by the race committee subject to prevailing weather conditions and waves.

7. START/FINISH

7.1. Races will be started in accordance with rule E3.4, following a 2 minute start sequence.

7.2. Start and finish line are the same.

7.3. Signals will be made orally.

8. PENALTIES

8.1. Rule 44.1 is changed to "a boat may take a One-Turn penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of either Part 2 or 31 in an incident while racing."

9. TIME LIMIT

9.1. The time limit for a race will be 20 minutes.

10. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

10.1. Protests will be delivered to the SSSC bar.

10.2. A boat's protest time limit is 5 minutes after completion of the final race.

11. SCORING

11.1. The low point scoring system will be used.

11.2. The value of a DNS (Did Not Start) or DNF (Did Not Finish) shall be the number of boats checked-in.

11.3. The value for a DNC (Did Not Compete) shall be the number of boats checked-in that day plus one (1).

11.4. Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst scores. The number of allowable scores to be excluded will be prorated based on the number of races completed as defined below:

12. PRIZES/WINNERS

12.1. Overall series winners are determined by taking their best average score from each series.

12.2. Prizes awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd.
