## Notice of Race



### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and the International Lightning Class Association (ILCA) Rules.
- 1.2 If there is a conflict between this notice and the sailing instructions the jury will determine the intent of the SIs in making a decision.

### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The Corn Roast Regatta is open to all boats of the ILCA
- 2.2 Entry forms will be available at SSYC on August 11 at 0800 CDT.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and delivering it, together with the required fee, to the fleet captain by August 15 at registration.

### 3 FEE

The entry fee will be \$30 payable at registration. Entry fee includes continental breakfast Saturday, plus awards.

- 4.2 5 races are scheduled. The last warning signal shall be no later than 1600.

### 5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

### 6 VENUE

The racing area will be on Lake Michigan northeast of the South Shore Fair Weather (Rubble) Gap, east of SSYC in an area to be determined by the race committee.



**7 THE COURSE**

The course to be sailed will be a windward- leeward of 2, 3, or 4 legs.

**8 PENALTY SYSTEM**

RRS 44.1 is changed so that for a boat that has her spinnaker drawing, the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty, including dropping the spinnaker completely, resetting it, and have it drawing immediately after the penalty. This changes RRS 44.

**9 SCORING**

**9.1** 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

**9.2** When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's regatta score will be the total of her race scores.

**10 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Use of VHF radios will be permitted for communication from the race committee to competitors on a VHF channel specified in the SIs. The race committee will attempt to make courtesy broadcasts. Each boat is responsible for its own VHF radio and deciding to listen for race committee communications.

**11 PRIZES**

Prizes will be given to the boats placing 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> in the regatta.

**12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. South Shore Yacht Club, its members and/or agents will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
