

# NOTICE OF RACE

Remote Control Sailing  
DF65 Princess Cup  
South Shore Yacht Club  
June 23, 2022

## 1. RULES

1.1. The regatta will be defined by the rules in the Racing Rules of Sailing: Appendix E and the Dragon Force 65 restricted class rules.

## 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The series is open to Dragon Force 65 “stock” with A rig sailboats only.
- 2.2. All boats shall be raced straight out of the box. No upgraded rigs or sails are permitted, except as provided in 2.3 below.
- 2.3. Lithium battery packs are permitted.
- 2.4. An eligible boat may enter by RSVPing on the DF65 Princess Cup Facebook Event Page as late as 5pm on race day..
- 2.5. All boats shall be individually identified with markings on their sails or unique sail numbers.

## 3. FEES

3.1. The event is free

## 4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. Participating boats shall register on the DF65 Facebook Event Page by 5pm on June 23, 2022.
- 4.2. Check in with Race Committee time is 6:15pm June 23, 2022.
- 4.3. First Warning time is 6:30pm on Thursday, June 23, 2022 (during the “Queen’s Cup Cocktail Party”).**
- 4.4. There will be no warnings after 8:00pm.

## 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. The Sailing Instructions will be posted online on the SSYC website and the DF65 Princess Cup Facebook Event Page. If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.

## 6. RACING AREA

6.1. The racing area will be in the South Shore Yacht Club horseshoe. The racing area may be changed by the race committee subject to prevailing weather conditions, waves, and congestion.

## 7. SCORING

- 7.1. The low point scoring system will be used.
- 7.2. The value of a DNS (Did Not Start) or DNF (Did Not Finish) shall be the number of boats checked-in.
- 7.3. Throw-outs will be detailed in the sailing instructions.

## 8. PRIZES

8.1. Awards: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd.
